Clauses 55 and 56 - age assessments

0	The Bill disqualifies potential victims of modern slavery and human trafficking from support and protection from removal from the UK - creating a risk of ongoing exploitation, disruption of recovery from trauma, and reduced opportunity to assist perpetrator prosecution.
