ST3 posts may be available at two points in the national specialty recruitment calendar, in what is known as National Round 2 (R2) and National Round 3 (R3).

Applications for recruitment into ST3 in R3, for posts starting in August/September 2025, will open from 10:00 on 14 November 2024. The full timeline is below.

As of 2024, ST3 is the only higher level entry point to the paediatric training pathway.

Update 8 November 2024 - following some queries from prospective applicants, the wording around the two clinical areas scored for shortlisting, have been adjusted to ensure clarity. All scoring and other descriptors remain unchanged.
